

## **THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT NOMINATING COMMISSION**

### **TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT BAR DISTRICT MAGISTRATE JUDGE VACANCY, POSITION NO. 2**

**July 28, 2022**

The Third Judicial District Nominating Commission is reopening the nomination process for the district magistrate judge vacancy, position number 2. The vacancy was created by the 2022 House Substitute for Substitute for Senate Bill 267 and certified by the April 15, 2022, Administrative Order 2022-JA-020. The Commission will convene at 9:00 a.m., on Friday, September 23, 2022, in the Shawnee County Courthouse to interview and appoint a district magistrate judge to fill the position.

Statutes require a district magistrate judge to be a graduate of a high school or secondary school or the equivalent; to be a resident of Shawnee County at the time of taking the oath of office and maintain residency in Shawnee County while holding such office; and to either be a lawyer admitted to practice law in Kansas or to pass an examination given by the Supreme Court and to become certified within 18 months, as provided by K.S.A. 20-334; 20-337; and 20-338.

The Commission will welcome recommendations of nominees to fill the position. Recommendations must be accompanied by a nomination form which is available in the offices of the Clerk of the Shawnee County District Court or Clerk of the Appellate Courts, online at [www.kscourts.org/judges](http://www.kscourts.org/judges) and at [www.shawneecourt.org](http://www.shawneecourt.org). The nomination form must be completed and signed by the nominee.

An original and one copy of the nomination form, together with a like number of any supporting letters, should be submitted on or before **noon on Monday, August 29, 2022**, to:
