STANDING ORDER

RE: Manner for providing notice for hearings for the enforcement of court ordered child visitation rights and parenting time pursuant to K.S.A. 23-3401.

K.S.A. 23-3401(f) provides in relevant part;

Notice of the hearing date set by the hearing officer shall be given to all interested parties by certified mail, return receipt requested, or as the court may order.

Mandatory Supplemental Orders pertaining to enforcement of child support require each party to inform the Clerk of the District Court in writing of any change of residence within seven days after any such change.

Effective immediately, the notice required by K.S.A. 23-3401(f) shall be sent via first class U.S. Mail addressed to all interested parties and counsel at their last known address on file with the Clerk of the District Court.
